Patrol Coverage

The Cambridge Police Department is staffed 24 hours per day 365 days per year, providing proactive policing patrols and response to calls. To accommodate this, we operate:

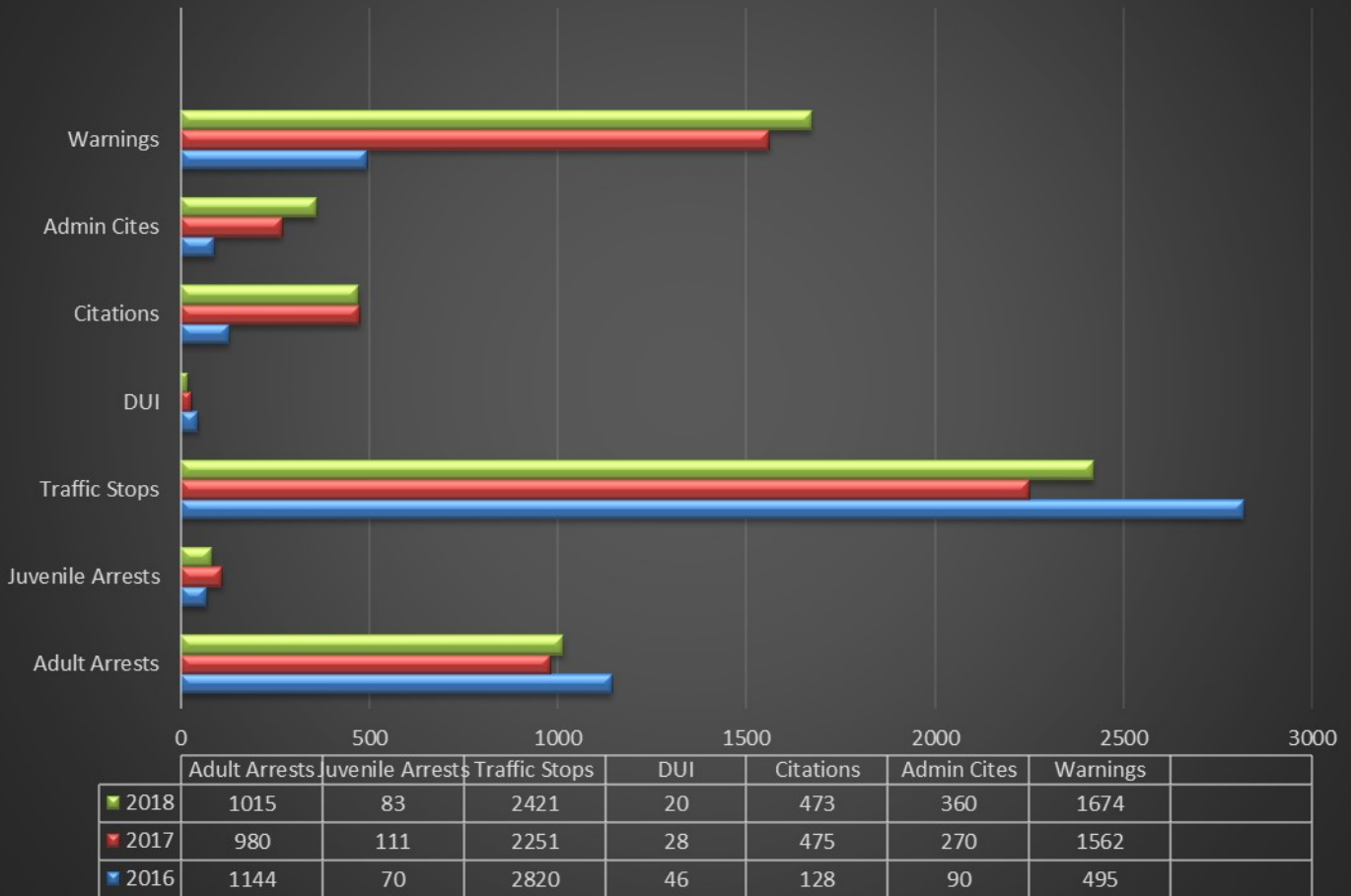
- Two 12-hour Patrol shifts per day
- Two Officers are scheduled from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm
- Two Officers work 6:00 pm to 6:00 am

One Sergeant works Monday-Friday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and supervises the day patrol, detectives and SRO’s. The second Sergeant supervises the night patrol officers and is on duty from 3:00 pm to 1:00 am Monday – Friday.

Our department strives to have two officers on duty at all times. However, due to vacation, sick leave, and court appearances for testimony, there may only be one Officer on duty periodically. Part-Time Police Officers help reduce the number of times this occurs.
